Discussion Item	Resolution Providing for a Reappointment to the Noise Control Board
Background	<p>The Noise Control Board was established by Ordinance 2002-35 to assist and advise the City on noise control issues, including administration and enforcement of the Noise Control Ordinance, and to adjudicate noise disturbance complaints.</p> <p>The Board is defined as having five to seven active members appointed by the Council. All members must be Takoma Park residents. Board members are appointed for staggered, three-year terms. Terms begin on April 1 and end on March 31. There are three vacancies on the seven-member Board.</p> <p>There are currently three vacancies on the Noise Control Board and one member whose term expired on March 31. Kathleen Berst has applied for reappointment to the Board.</p>
