ORDINANCE NO. 2004-10

AN ORDINANCE TO PURCHASE MOBILE COMPUTER CLIENT SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, The City has desired to participate in the Public Safety Communications System of Montgomery County (formerly known as the PS 2000 project), AND

WHEREAS, voice radio equipment and mobile computing hardware equipment has already been procured, AND

WHEREAS, these mobile computers are being installed and/or used in police vehicles, AND

WHEREAS, the County has awarded contracts to TRW, Inc., which was acquired by Northrop-Grumman Commercial Systems, Inc., for the development and customization of software relating to the project, making it a sole source provider, AND

WHEREAS, a waiver of the Nuclear Free Zone Act provisions has already been granted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND

SECTION 1. THAT the quotation from Northrop-Grumman, in accordance with its contract with Montgomery County, is for \$2200 per user license, including installation. The Department has 19 mobile computer units, requiring 19 licenses to operate, for a total cost of \$41,800.00 in expenses.

SECTION 2 THAT this software will be purchased and used to bring the existing hardware into operation with the Montgomery County PSCS., providing CAD and MILES/NCIC interface capabilities.
