**CONTRACT AWARD FOR PAVILION AND PATHWAY
INSTALLATION AT TOATLEY FRASER PARK**

WHEREAS, the FY06 budget includes \$44,500 for site improvements at Toatley Fraser Park; and,

WHEREAS, the monies for these improvements are budgeted in Special Revenue Fund Account 0010-7194; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the City's procurement procedure, a Request for Proposals was advertised and mailed to interested vendors; and;

WHEREAS, bids were publicly opened on September 10, 2003, with three (3) bids being received; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department determined that Triple J Construction, Inc. submitted the lowest and most responsive bid; and,

WHEREAS, Triple J Construction will honor their original bid price for the pavilion and pathway installation; and,

WHEREAS, the Acting Public Works Director recommends awarding a contract to Triple J Construction for the pavilion and pathway installation; and,

WHEREAS, funds are available in the budget to award said contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT:

SECTION 1 The bid for the installation of a picnic pavilion and pathway in Toatley Fraser Park be awarded to Triple J Construction; and,

SECTION 2 The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Triple J Construction in the amount of \$23,256.
